# 1 Viz Channel Branding 5.2.0

These are the release notes with changes since 5.1.0.

## 1.1 New Features

- Housekeeper Service - a context-aware data synchronization service.
  - Integrations Hub REST API v2 additions with full GET/POST/PUT/DELETE support for channel pool.
  - Integrations Hub REST API v2 additions with being able to PUT any Page Content to a page in page pool and playlist.
  - Integrations Hub REST API v2 additions with being able to GET full list of Templates from template pool and GET on single Template from template pool.
  - Integrations Hub REST API v2 additions with being able to PUT on a Page in page pool to update any page's description, time-to-live or default duration.
  - Integer and Float field editor added to Page Editor.

## 1.2 Improvements

- Import of Ticker Buttons is now supported for more file encodings, such as UTF-16 with and without Byte Order Mark.
  - When a Page Content Filling playlist query is invalid the Promo Server now returns the proper error code instead of a message indicating a general failure to find a match for the query.
  - Multiple icons and components in playlist and channel settings has received new and improved versions.
  - IntHub v2 REST API: allow property CreatedBy to be optional for PUT requests - will retain current value in this case.
  - Possible to copy-paste elements across playlists in a channel.
  - Created By property is now tracked for primary event as well.
  - Upgrade Tool now allows for migration and upgrade of channels containing Viz Trio-created pages as well as Combo pages.
  - Codepage can now be set for Playlist Importer's LST Import module.
  - Optional setting added to Marina Integration Module to force deletion of Message elements or non-matching pages when pushing Page updates to a playlist.

## 1.3 Changed Features

- For AnyText and Excel Import Modules the optional setting 'Header Lines in File' / 'Header Lines Included' is merged into the 'Skip Line' option.


- The Confirmation dialog of pages when deleting a Template is now only shown if there exist one or multiple pages created from this Template.
  - Playlist column 'Page name' renamed to 'Cf. page' to match meaning of 'copied from page' as it indicates nearest parent as a breadcrumb.

## 1.4 Fixed Issues

- Scene Importer now fully support extended characters as part of Page Field data.
  - Playlist column Take Count is now updated in real-time when events are taken on air.
  - Was possible to crash the Playlist Importer using a rarely used command parameter.
  - Pilot Data Element (PDE) column in playlist now updates in real time.
  - Preview of page data in Page Editor now also works for Viz Engine 5.x+.
  - Fixed issue regarding column resizing for Action Pool.
  - NDI Stream discover for Channel Deck is now case-agnostic.
  - Scene Importer now handle scene descriptions that contain special characters.

## 1.5 System Requirements

- Windows 7 64-bit (only), or higher
- Microsoft .NET Framework 4.8
- Media Sequencer 5.3 or higher
- Viz Engine 3.14 or higher, with Viz Engine 5.2 or higher recommended
- Graphic Hub REST 2.4.2 or higher
- Media Codecs (K-lite Codec Pack full)

## 1.6 Migration

### 1.6.1 Migrating from Viz Multichannel to Channel Branding 5.0+

1. Uninstall previous version.
  2. Install Viz Channel Branding 5.0+ component 'Upgrade Tool'.
  3. Run 'Upgrade Tool' and 'Migrate' and then 'Upgrade' appropriate channels. This is a two-step process, first the data migration, then a final data-upgrade pass.
