1.1 Main Features


- Tags
 - Tags added to a Space will be applied to all resources deployed by Viz Now.
 - Organization admins can define tags that can be applied to Spaces, both with selectable options or customizable text.
 - Organization admins can define mandatory tags that must be applied to Spaces.
 - Organization admins can define tags that will be applied to all Spaces.

1.2 Breaking Changes

- Existing tags on existing spaces will be removed and Spaces created before 1.2.4. will *not* apply tags in AWS.
- Templates will no longer have any predefined tags.

1.3 Fixed Issues

- New g4 and g5 instances running Windows OS will now mostly use NVIDIA driver 538.15. Release Notes, supported GPUs and other documentation can be found at: <https://docs.nvidia.com/datacenter/tesla/index.html>
